All harvested deer on Fort Stewart must be presented at the check station during the posted dates and operating hours above.

Deer presented at the check station will not count against your statewide season limit. Check Station personnel will issued GA DNR bonus tags for the collection of biological data.

Deer presented at the check station will count against your Fort Stewart season bag limit of 5 deer.

Deer harvested on Hunter Army Airfield (HAAF) on the above dates are not required to be presented at the check station. Deer harvested at HAAF on these dates will count against your statewide and installation bag limit **OR**

HAAF deer can be brought to the check station on open days to receive a GA DNR bonus tag

Hunters will be issued a maximum of 2 GA DNR bonus tags per check station operating period. ***The December Check Station dates are considered one operating period.***

The Check Station is located 0.2 miles East of GA HWY 144 and Old Sunbury Rd intersection (Next to Fire Station #7 and the Archery/Personal Firearms Ranges)

Feral hogs are not required to be presented at the check station.
